A Message from ABLE Superintendent Clem Lee

Greetings, ABLE Families.

Summer school is up and running. Our faculty and staff have been working diligently to prepare a high-quality program and we are thrilled to have students and adults back on our campus and in our classrooms.

As we prepare for a complete return to campus in the fall, we know you have many questions. Our front office team does a great job disseminating information and keeping leadership informed of the things that parents are asking about. In this update I will attempt to anticipate and answer some of those questions. You will see this information again.

- The school year will begin on Monday, August 23. We have posted the instructional calendar on our calendars page, and you can also see it [HERE](#).
- ABLE's bell schedules and pickup/drop off times have changed since we were last on campus during the 2019-2020 school year. ABLE Elementary (grades K-4) classes will run from 8:00am – 2:00pm on regular school days, and from 8:00am – 1:30pm on minimum days. ABLE Middle and High School (grade 5-12) classes will run from 7:50am – 3:00pm on regular school days, and from 7:50am – 2:10pm on minimum days. ABLE elementary students with older siblings in middle or high school will be able to stay in a “between school” program from the time their day ends until their sibling is out of school. “between school” is separate from ABLE's formal after school program. There is no cost to participate in the “between school” program whereas the after school program comes with a cost.
- ABLE's After School Program (ASP) will be available to students in grades TK-8. The ASP will run from the time school ends until 6:00pm. In the coming weeks we will post an online application for the ASP program complete with cutoff dates and information about pricing.
