A Message from ABLE Superintendent Clem Lee

Greetings, ABLE Families.

The legislature yesterday approved two substantial bills to provide incentives for school to reopen for in-person instruction and resources to address student's learning loss during the pandemic. The governor is expected to sign the legislation into law.

We are analyzing the bills carefully so that we can, at last, provide a clear and final decision about teaching and learning at ABLE.

Next week you may expect a decision on the following:

- whether or not school will reopen for in-person instruction during this school year,
- plans for a robust summer session, and
- the possibility of an earlier start date this fall to get students back and learning as soon as possible.

My goal is to have a plan posted by midweek.
