ABLE thanks our families who attended the virtual townhall meeting on November 19 to review our school's reopening plan and to provide feedback.

Approximately 100 families attended. We are grateful for your support and participation.

ABLE will now message families and ask for a formal decision about remaining in distance learning or returning to campus when we are able to reopen.

Since we began planning for reopening San Joaquin County has returned to the purple tier under which we may not reopen. We have no way of knowing whether SJC will return to the red tier before our projected reopening on January 28.

Our intention is to proceed with our reopening plans to ensure that we may reopen with an in-person option when we are legally able to do so.

December 1 – 4 regarding	Messaging to families and request for formal decisions distance or in-person learning.
December 7 – 11 advisor	Push to have families complete selection process including contact and staff phone calls.
December 14 – 18 respond	Final decisions received or made for families that do not to survey.
January 4 – 8 the plan schedules are revised	Finalize changes to teaching assignments to accommodate and inform faculty. Master schedule and student to reflect families' choices.
January 11 – 15 schedules.	Make necessary adjustments to student and teacher
January 11 – 22 staff to be tested and determine through the end of the school year.	Determine the appropriate window for requiring all ABLE for COVID-19 in readiness for in-person student contact intervals for regular employee testing
January 19 – 27 administrators	Schedule a non-student contact day for teachers and to internalize the plan and prepare for implementation.
January 28	ABLE reopens pending state and county permission.
