ABLE Announces an Early College, Career Pathway for Incoming Freshmen!

**Information has been mailed to families of incoming 9th graders
regarding the
Legacy Teacher Career Pathway!**

ABLE Charter and Humphreys University will launch the Legacy Teacher Career Pathway when school starts on August 22. The program consists of combined ABLE and early college through Humphreys University that can qualify a student for a bachelor's degree by the end of the senior year and a teaching credential one or two years later – all at very low or no cost. Eligible students can even be employed as teachers at ABLE AND enrolled in the Humphreys master's program a year later.

This is a phenomenal opportunity!

Incoming 9th graders are invited to enroll. Space is limited, but ABLE will do everything in its power to enroll all interested students.

Families should indicate their interest immediately in one of these three ways:
